I think we must have a prity good country after all. I see by the paper sheep is dieing on a count of the drowth in Montana this summer, but from the way Lafe talks its different – with ours sounds good to me. Well I am going to be changed to Burnley will go the last of this week don't know the adress yet so you will have to send your next lettr to Chorley as useal. have been in Chorley eight months and a half, and it looks like the branch will brake up. 4 of them will leave for Australia soon. We have been holding meeting at Walls he talks like he is going to brake up is home. Sister Walls went of and left him Saturday went to her mother, and Walls was spouting around tell what he was going to do. I told him he ought to be a shamed of him self to talk the way he did, but he is very radical I don't think I would help him out now if I could showed is color. he seemes to have a strong testimony of the gospel, but he don't treat is whife rite and I told him so, she is a loving little thing and he is so domineering over her. Walls was telling us is story all day, and after we left we met Sister Walls coming home and she told us a little of her side of the question all to gather differant: but I suppose thay ar al rite this morning. Glad I am going to leave. Burnley is one of the larges branches in the conference.
