Couldent come up to her mothers so I went down to Bath and stayed all knight at Roses and Molley came over in the evening dident have time to talk gospel with her. She is quite an old lady over 50 now. I told her you wanted me to take her back with me but she said she wouldent like to leave Bath, and it is a nice place. I told her you didnt relize what a beatifull country it was.

Molley is a good Woman but I wouldent want to encorage her to leave this country unless she was converted to mormonism. I am going to write to her and send her some books to read. will have to send her a picture. I gave Rose one and one to Edward.

Rose is a lively little Woman. Has a nice Husband he got of is work and took all kind of pains to make me have a good time.

I enjoyed myself at Edwards allso. He is a nice young man farmer and he took me out and showed me is farm.
