Samuel Jackson, of Manassa, Colo, who had been here about ten weeks visiting his sister-in-law, Mrs Myra Adams, passed away at the latter's home on Saturday, May 3. He had the 'flu' last October which left him with a weak heart and asthma. He went to the coast in hopes of being benefited but got no improvement there so came to St. George, where he died of the trouble stated. Samuel Jackson was 75 years old and was bishop of Manassa ward for 21 years, resigning when ill health overtook him. He is survived by two wives and seven children. One of his wives, Mrs Martha Jackson, a sister of Mrs Myra Adams of this city was with him during his illness and death here.
