as soon as ~~Sam~~ gets back
so it will all depend on
how we ~~find~~ the range.
we have got to get these
sheep fat if I dont get ^{some} all
summer we are through
lambing and shearing
now ready to start.

and the sheep ought to
be out. when I come home
I would like to get time
to finish painting the house
and we will have to get
all our pitchmen ~~take~~
